The British Columbia Racquetball Association Board of Directors code of ethics is a policy prescribing the actions, expectations, and restrictions of board members. The policy is used as formal mechanism to inform each director as to the code of ethics that they are expected to uphold during their involvement with the BC Racquetball Association.

As a member of the BCRA Board of Directors, I have a responsibility to:

1. Represent the interests of all people served by this organization.
2. Not use the organization or my service on this board for my own personal advantage or for the individual advantage of my associates.
3. Keep confidential information confidential.
4. Approach all board issues with an open mind, prepared to make the best decision for the whole organization.
5. Do nothing to violate the trust of those who elected me to the board or of those we serve.
6. Focus my efforts on the mission of the organization and not on my personal goals.
7. Never exercise authority as a board member except when acting in a meeting with the full board or as I am delegated by the board.
8. Treat everyone fairly within the context of their activity, regardless of gender, place of origin, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political belief or economic status.
